

Project database - Tempus, Erasmus Mundus and Lifelong Learning Programme

This is a database of Tempus, Erasmus Mundus and Lifelong Learning Programme projects in which higher education institutions from Serbia as well as other types of institutions have taken part. One can find in it:

- An overview of all projects and basic data about their participants – institutions and individuals,
- Objectives, activities and project results at institutions achieved at Serbian institutions,
- Data about equipment purchased within projects for Serbian institutions,
- Useful documents created in the course of project implementation.

Your suggestions for database improvement are always welcome.

Instruction for database use

Title: an original project title from its project application; it can be in English, French or German (possible application languages prescribed by programme rules). Search is possible even if you type only part of a title or a (key) word from the title.

Reference: a unique project referent number in EACEA project database for internal use e.g. 18069, 145703.

Application year: the year in which a project application is submitted. You can choose projects submitted in a certain year (=), project submitted before and including (\leq) or after and including (\geq) a certain year. Database covers projects starting from the year 2000 on. An exception is the year 2007 in which there was no Call for Tempus projects. For centralized LLP actions database contains projects in which Serbia participated from 2010 (as a “third country” in 2010, and in 2011 and 2012 as a full member).

Duration: Database contains projects with eligibility periods of one, two or three years (=), projects the duration of which was shorter or equal to certain duration (\leq) and longer and equal to one, two or three years. In Tempus phase III (2001-2006) projects could have 1, 2 or 3-year duration, while in Tempus IV the eligibility period has been either 2 or 3 years.

Project status: Two options are possible „finalized“ or „on-going“. Please note that Tempus projects could get up to one-year extension of eligibility period.

Objectives: Search by inserting a specific word that is associated with project objectives definitions, as stated in project application.

Acronym: Project short name, made of initial letter/part of words from the titles.

Person: Search by naming a person involved in project implementation. Database contains the names of all official project coordinators and contact persons for Serbian institutions as well as persons involved in project implementation teams.

Scope: Projects can be *national* if its participants are institutions from Serbia and European Union; *regional* – if its participant institutions are from Western Balkans countries (including Serbia) and EU; *multi-country* – if their participants are, in addition to Serbia and other WB countries, from some other region e.g. Northern Africa (e.g. Egypt) or Eastern partnership (e.g. Moldavia) and from EU.

Programme: Names of programmes and sub-programmes are given in capital letters (TEMPUS, LIFELONG LEARNING PROGRAMME, COMENIUS etc. Types of projects are in small letters (*joint projects, structural measures, multilateral project*).

Partner: Search by entering the whole title or part of the title of partner institutions from Serbia and other countries.

Subject area: Mainly related to EACEA categories of possible subject areas for projects.

Participant country: Search for projects in which institutions from a particular country have taken part.

Equipment type: Search by entering the name of a specific category of equipment purchased within projects. Please note that collecting data about equipment is still on-going.

Equipment title: Search by entering equipment title.
